Exterior

- Roof: No missing or damaged shingles
- ☐ Chimney: No cracks, cap is secure
- ☐ Gutters: Clean and attached properly
- ☐ Siding/Stucco: In good condition, no cracks or warping
- ☐ Windows/Doors: Open and close properly, no broken glass
- Yard: No standing water; lawn mowed, bushes trimmed

✓ Interior

General Areas

- □ Ceilings: No cracks or stains
- ☐ Floors: No sagging, warping, or buckling
- □ Walls: No leaning or major cracks
- Doors: Close and latch correctly
- ☐ Windows: Seal tightly, no drafts
- □ Under sinks: No leaks

Kitchen

- □ Appliances working
- Cabinets and drawers open smoothly
- ☐ Stove and range hood vent properly
- Plumbing under sink leak-free
- ☐ Floors clean and in good shape

Bathrooms

- ☐ Sinks, toilet, and tub/shower work
- □ Exhaust fan functions
- Caulking and grout in good shape
- □ No leaks or signs of water damage

Outside Spaces

Front Yard

- Driveway and walkway in good condition
- □ Outdoor lights work
- Lawn and landscaping well-maintained
- □ Garage door opens smoothly

Backyard

- ☐ Deck, patio, or pool in safe condition
- □ Fence and gates sturdy
- □ Lawn neat
- □ Shed/doors secure

Basement

- ☐ No moisture or wet spots
- □ Wood structures intact
- ☐ HVAC unit in working order

Attic

- ☐ Insulation and ventilation in good shape
- □ No mold or blocked vents
- ☐ Wiring looks safe and tidy

Living Areas

- ☐ Windows/screens, doors, stairs, and lighting all work
- No visible wall or ceiling damage
- ☐ Smoke/CO detectors installed and working
